The United States Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") has issued ORBCOMM a blanket license (the "Blanket License") to operate mobile Earth terminals with its Non-Voice, Non-Geostationary mobile satellite system. FCC Call Sign E940534, 10 FCC Rcd 6572 (1995). Pursuant to the Blanket License and Sections 25.115(d) and 25.135 of the FCC's Rules (47 CFR §§ 25.115(d) & 25.135), the FCC has delegated to ORBCOMM the responsibility for equipment approval ("type approval") in accordance with the FCC's Rules and policies, with respect to the mobile Earth terminals operating in conjunction with the ORBCOMM System.

Pursuant to that responsibility, ORBCOMM has analyzed the Digi M10 subscriber communicator (TAN 010DGI) for general applications. ORBCOMM is pleased to certify that this product conforms to the FCC requirements listed above along with those requirements set forth by ORBCOMM.
